



iSticky 3.5

Note shortcuts

Command .	Mark.
Command R	Reply to the sender of this note.
Option Command R	Reply to the sender of this note and delete note afterwards.
Command F	Forward note.
Command E	Edit the note. When this note is stored on the server also, there will be sent a new version of this note after accepting the changes.
Command D	Make this note local and delete it on the server.
Command Y	Delete note and save in archive.
Command I	Transfer note to iPod.
Command J	Lock/unlock a note
Down or Tab	Select the next note.
Up or Shift Tab	Select the previous note.
Command Up	Collapse note.
Command Down	Expand note.
Command /	Reset note.
Command Backspace	Trash note.
Command]	Reset options.
Option Down, Up, Left, Right	Move note 1 pixel.
Shift Option Down, Up, Left, Right	Move note 10 pixels.

Services menu

Shift Command >	Send a note.
Shift Command <	Create a local note.

Note mouse events

Single click	With one click on the note, the note will be in front of all others. If the mouse is moving during the click, the note will be draggable and placed where the pressed condition of the mouse is discontinued.
Double click	After pressing the mouse button twice, the so called - doubleclick, the note will open its edit window.
Control click	Pressing (and hold it) the controlkey on the keyboard and doing a single mouseclick, will display a contextual menu with all possible actions.

Getting started

At first startup, iSticky will ask you how you want to use it: local, via Bonjour or via internet. Of course you can use all three ways together, but using iSticky via Bonjour or internet may need some configuration. When you want to use iSticky via internet too, you need a free account on our global iStickyServer. If you don't signup at first startup, you can signup later by choosing menu Options-Server-Configure and selecting the Signup button.

Firewall

When you are behind a firewall, you might have some problems using iSticky. iSticky uses port 12300 to communicate with iStickyServer and port 12330 to communicate with iStickySubServer. Opening this port might solve possible problems. The iSticky communication between different Mac's on your Local Area Network is completely done through port 12300.

AppleScript (new in v3.2.1)

Included are some examples of script which can be used to create notes by other software.

License

You can use your iSticky account for free during the trial period of 30 days. If you don't get licensed during the trial period, your iSticky account (if you did a signup) will be deleted after some time. For licensing, please look at <http://www.xinfinite.nl>

iStickySubServer

All iSticky licenses can use this server software on your local network and is free of charge. Download it at: <http://www.isticky.net/downloads/istickysubserver.zip>

Minimum system requirements

A PowerMac G4 and Mac OS X 10.4.11
Version 3.4 is optimized for Snow Leopard.

Known note conversion issue

If you are using iSticky1 or iSticky2 at this moment please update first to version 2.6.1. Doing this will convert all your notes and archive to the right structure. After running iSticky261 the notes and archive will be ready for the upgrade to iSticky3. iSticky 2.6.1 can be downloaded at: <http://www.isticky.net/downloads/isticky261.dmg>. Backup your iSticky 2.x datafiles before conversions!

Known issues Secure Email

SSL for .Mac and Gmail isn't supported in this release, we are working on that.

Known issues with other shareware

At this moment iSticky is not compatible with Ape and some other Unsanity tools, use its ExcludeList to exclude iSticky. More info about this can be found at: http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Application_Enhancer
