



About The Software : A basic 10 page notebook which is handy for holding text while you cut, copy & paste between different programs. It allows you to get around the limitations of a single clipboard in Windows. Nothing special here, just a quick utility for everyday use.

All text and settings are automatically saved on exit and loaded when restarting the program, so you don't have to worry about saving or opening files manually. You can also customize the interface with your own colour and font preferences to suit your requirements.

- 10 pages to store plain text
- Rename buttons for identification
- Dock toolbar any side of window
- Change font and colour settings
- Popup menu with cut, copy, paste
- All text automatically saves on exit
- Text and settings auto-load on start

System Requirements : Windows 95/98/ME/2000/XP/Vista

Installation

1. Unzip all the files to a suitable folder on your hard drive
for example ... C:\Cybia\Pasteboard
2. Create a shortcut to the Pasteboard.exe file to launch the application

To uninstall just delete the folder where you installed the program files to. Also delete the Pasteboard.ini file that has been automatically created in your Windows folder (this is where your settings are stored, so keep a backup if you want to reuse it at a later time). Finally, remove any shortcuts that you have created manually for the program.



Pasteboard Quick Reference Guide

Version 2.1

Main Program : This screenshot (right) shows the basic program layout. At the top you will find the toolbar with page buttons labelled 1-10 (which you can change for your own descriptions).

Clicking on each button will switch between the different pages, where you can type or paste your plain text for later use with other applications.

The toolbar can be dragged and docked to any side of the program window, top, bottom, left or right.

The Toolbar : You can make the text larger and easier to read by changing the font settings.

Text Popup Menu : If you right-click anywhere in the text window area then a popup menu will appear. This will allow you to access the common editing features such as copy and paste.

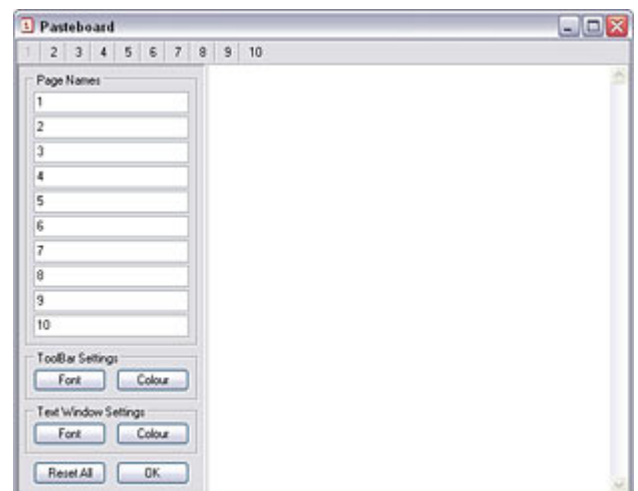
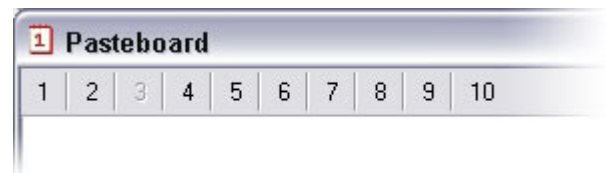
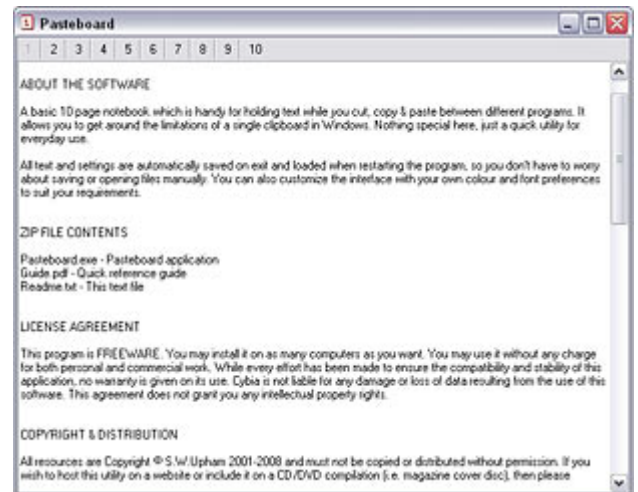
Toolbar Popup Menu : If you right-click anywhere on the toolbar then a popup menu will appear, providing access to the settings panel.

Settings Panel : You can modify various parts of Pasteboard from here. Clicking on the popup menu link (see above) will display this panel on the left hand side of the program window.

Type your new page descriptions in the edit boxes provided and the buttons will automatically update.

Click on the Font or Colour buttons to change the interface to suit your requirements.

You can revert to the default settings at any time by clicking the Reset All button. Click the OK button to exit the settings panel.

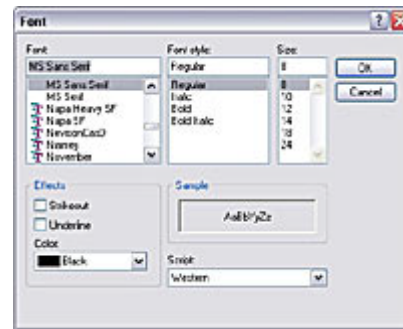




Pasteboard Quick Reference Guide

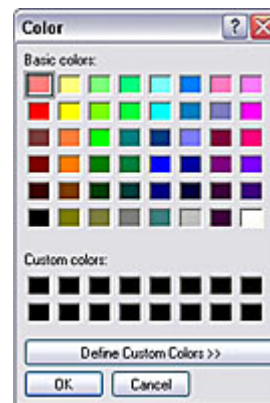

Windows Font Dialog : You can call the standard font dialog in Windows in order to change the text settings for the toolbar and text pages. Click on the Font buttons to modify the text size, colour and typeface to suit your preferences.



Windows Colour Dialog : If you would like to change the default colour of the toolbar background area and the text windows, then click on the Colour buttons and this will call the standard colour dialog in Windows.

Select a colour from the basic range shown or define your own custom colour by extending the dialog options. When you are done click OK to return to the program.
