

SPA Logging – Program Date: 19th June 2005

Installation

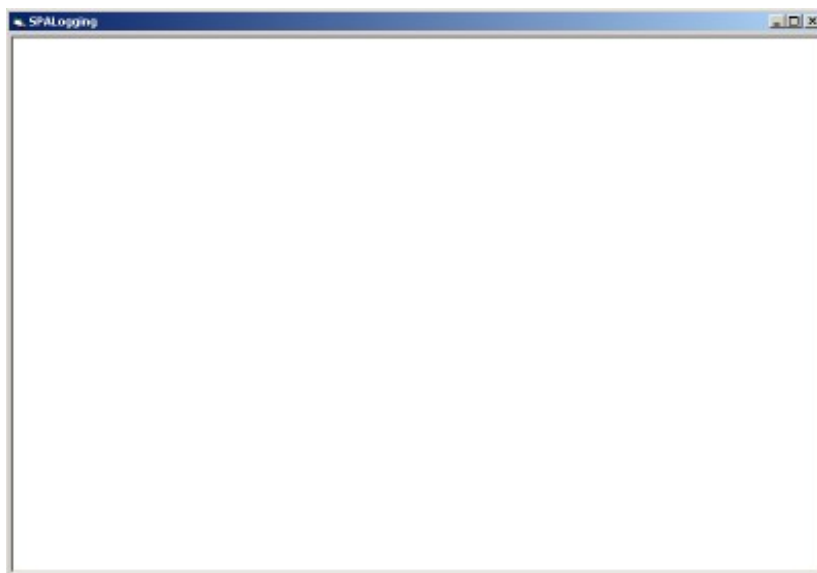
Simple.. as long as you have the database drivers:

Microsoft MDAC from http://google.com/search?q=MDAC_TYP.exe+site%3Amicrosoft.com

You should be ok.

Extract the files and run SPALogging.exe.

You should see a screen similar to



This is the default logging screen.

You now need to go into your SPA configuration at the following address:

<http://<SPA IP>/admin/advanced>

Click the System tab.

Find “Optional Network Configuration” further down the page.

Leave “Syslog Server: “ blank and fill in “Debug Server: “ with:

<Machine running logging program>:6177

Under “Debug Level” set it to 1, 2 or 3 (3 being the most information) depending how much junk you want in your log.

See below for an example setup....

Save the changes and you should then see a load of logged information appear on SPALogging! This info saved to mylog.txt and in database format in log.mdb.
